Activity #6 – Last Letter Audiovisual

This exhibition includes an audiovisual presentation of the last letter written by [Mordecai Anielewicz](#), leader of the ZOB resistance organization and Commander of the resistance fighters in the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, to Deputy Commander Yitzhak Zuckerman. Have students watch the [video](#) of the letter being read aloud. After they have watched the video, have students respond to the following journal prompts:

1. How would you describe the tone of the letter? Pull out evidence from the letter to support your opinion.
2. What are your reactions to reading this letter? Reference words or phrases from the letter to assist in describing your reaction.
3. What is the significance of the fact that this was the last letter written by Mordecai before his death?
4. What do you think is the legacy of the Jewish resistance fighters in the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising?
