Vocabulary List

- ✚ **Advocate** - one who defends or maintains a cause or proposal; one who supports or promotes the interests of a cause or group
- ✚ **Give** - to put into the possession of another for his or her use; to offer for consideration, acceptance, or use
- ✚ **Participate** - to take part
- ✚ **Raise Awareness** – to bring attention to a cause, person, or thing
- ✚ **Upstander** - a person who speaks or acts in support of an individual or cause, particularly someone who intervenes on behalf of a person being attacked or bullied
- ✚ **Human Rights** - rights (such as freedom from unlawful imprisonment, torture, and execution) regarded as belonging fundamentally to all persons
- ✚ **Responsibility** - the state or fact of being answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management; something that it is your job or duty to deal with
- ✚ **Civil Rights**- the nonpolitical rights of a citizen; the rights of personal liberty guaranteed to U.S. citizens by the 13th and 14th amendments to the Constitution and by acts of Congress
- ✚ **Activism** - a doctrine or practice that emphasizes direct vigorous action especially in support of or opposition to one side of a controversial issue
- ✚ **Pledge** - a token, sign, or earnest of something else; a binding promise or agreement to do or forbear
