

Reader's Theater

Use the poem as the script for a reader's theatre activity. Reader's Theater involves small groups of participants reading and perhaps acting out the script. There is no memorization, limited rehearsal, and performance without full costume or props.

- 1. As a class, decide on how to divide up the poem: The individual lines may be read by specific students, by small groups, by the entire class as a choral reading, or a combination of all of these.
- 2. Assign the lines from the poem to the readers, based on the choices made in part 1.
- 3. Be sure to stress that this activity is not designed to be a role-play, simulation or mini-theater production.
- 4. Read the poem aloud according to the choices made in parts 1 and 2, as practice. Discuss if the class wants to describe

Post-Activity Discussion:

- Why did we do this activity?
- Does anyone want to share how they would have done another group's reading differently?
