

Activity #3 (optional to Activity #2)

If your students are unable to contribute to the site digitally, they can still share their family heirlooms and a brief story about what the object is and why they chose it with their classmates. Follow the instructions below:

- 1. Have students pick out an object and draw a picture of it.
- 2. Next, have students write at least 5 sentences on what the object is, why they chose it, and what they find meaningful about the object. They can write their sentences directly on the paper where they drew their object in the same style as the photographs from *Stories of Survival*. *Object*. *Image*. *Memory*.
- 3. (optional) Have students create a short video showcasing their drawing (and the real object, if they can) and explain to the class why they chose it and why it is meaningful to them.
