

Make a Family Jig Saw Puzzle Summer Upstander Activity Club Week Three

This is a project that can be done as a team, and it should be of your family. This puzzle can be a picture of your whole family, your favorite cousins, or even you and a pet. You could even draw a picture of your family!

## Here is what you'll need:

Image – A photo, print out, magazine page, a drawing you created.

**Thick paper** – A cereal box is really the perfect thickness for this project. You could use an old tissue box, or the cardboard from a shoe box.

Glue & a paintbrush or a q-tip.

Scissors - you can ask an adult to help with this part if you like

The puzzle pattern: see the bottom of the page!

- 1. Print out the puzzle pattern you like best.
- 2. Using the cardboard from a cereal box, lightly glue the puzzle pattern to the cardboard, so you can see the pattern. Use your paint brush or qtip so its smooth.
- 3. Flip it over, and glue the picture you like to it. Let this dry all the way. It might be best to place a few heavy books on top, so that it dries very flat.
- 4. Carefully, using scissors cut the pieces out! Congrats! You made your very own puzzle!
